Emergency Situation in Uttar Pradesh

Situation Report:

After the massive devastation in Uttarakhand, flood incidents were also reported from other states i.e. Uttar Pradesh and Assam. In Uttar Pradesh, continuous rainfall has worsened the flood situation with claiming over hundred of lives and damaging standing crops and livestock. The water released by upstream dams and barrages due to heavy rainfall in Uttarakhand and Nepal also raises the water level in the major rivers which are now following above the danger mark.

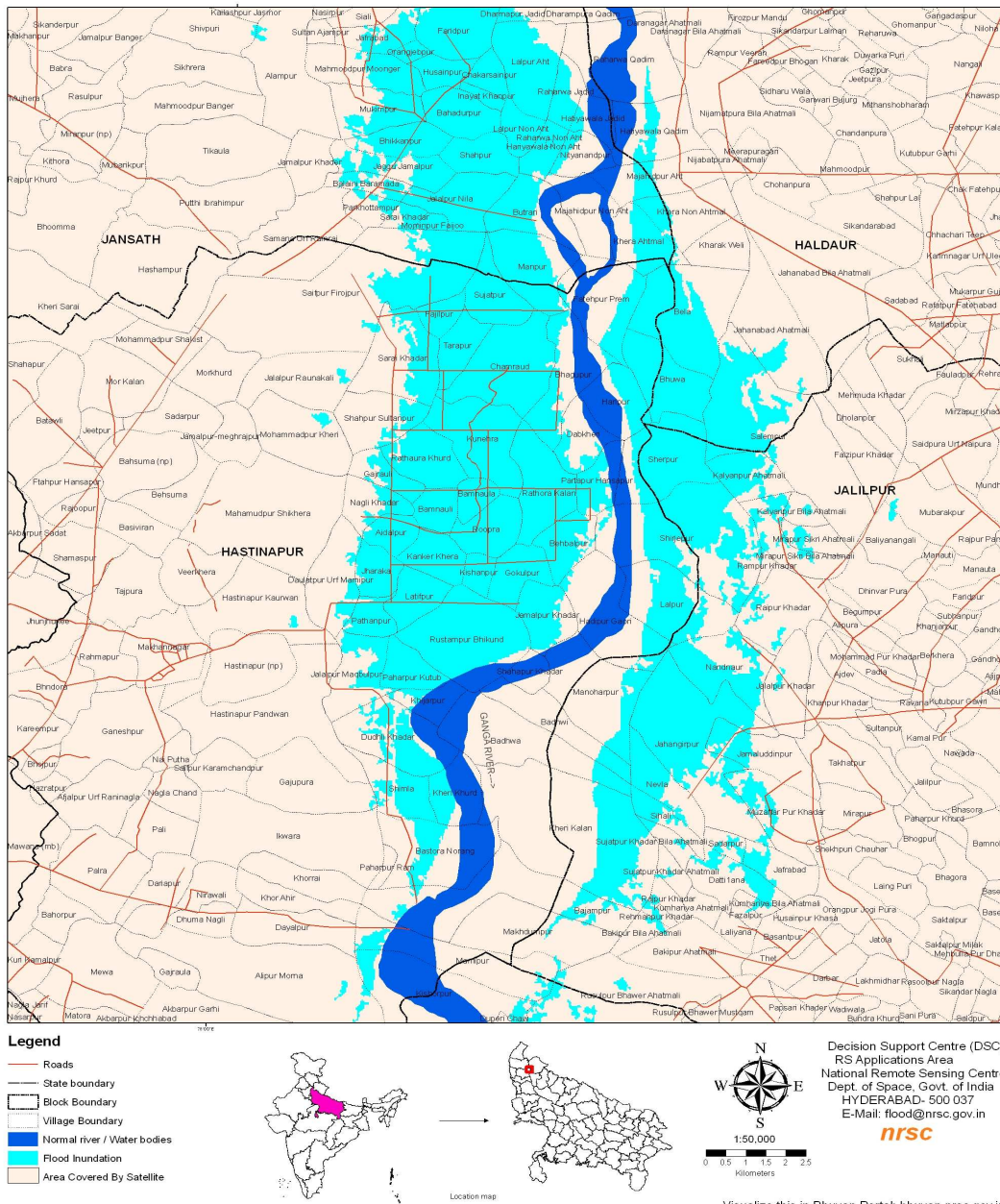
