



## A. IMD Update

### **31 July (Day 2):**

- ◆ Heavy to very heavy rainfall would occur at a few places with isolated extremely heavy falls over Chhattisgarh, Gujarat region and Saurashtra. Heavy to very heavy rainfall would occur at a few places over Vidarbha and Konkan & Goa. Heavy to very heavy rainfall would occur at isolated places over Odisha, east Madhya Pradesh, Kutch and Madhya Maharashtra.
- ◆ Heavy rainfall would occur at isolated places over west Madhya Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Telangana and coastal & south interior Karnataka.

### **01 August (Day 3):**

- ◆ Heavy to very heavy rainfall would occur at a few places with isolated extremely heavy falls over Saurashtra & Kutch. Heavy to very heavy rainfall would occur at a few places over Gujarat region. Heavy to very heavy rainfall would occur at isolated places over Konkan & Goa and Madhya Maharashtra.
- ◆ Heavy rainfall would occur at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, east Madhya Pradesh, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Karnataka and Kerala.

### **Weather Outlook for subsequent 4 days**

- ◆ Rain/thundershowers would occur at most places along west coast.
- ◆ Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over western Himalayan region, Indo-Gangetic plains, east and adjoining central India and northeastern states.
- ◆ Subdued rainfall activity would occur over interior peninsular India.

## B. Central Water Commission (daily water levels and forecasts for level at forecast sites)

According to the Central Water Commission (CWC) report dated 30.07.2014, there are 04 Moderate flood situation sites in the country:-

### **Assam**

- River Brahmaputra at Neamatighat, Distt- Jorhat, Assam is flowing 85.32(m) against the danger level 85.04(m) with rising trend.
- River Dhansri(s) at Nimalighat, Distt- Jorhat, Assam is flowing 77.69(m) against the danger level 77.42(m) with steady trend.

### **Bihar**

- River Kosi at Basua, Distt- Supaul, Bihar is flowing 47.79(m) against the danger level 47.75(m) with steady trend.

- River Ghagra at Elginbridge Distt. Bara Banki, Uttar Pradesh is flowing 106.32(m) against the danger level 106.07(m) with rising trend.
