Critical Situation of Elgin Charsadi Embankment

- Elgin Charsadi embankment start from Elgin Brig at Barabanki to Charsadi village which is in Gonda district.
- Elgin - Charsadi embankment facing again critical situation at kilometer 11.750 due to Ghaghara River totally eroded three main Spar and six Dampeners in area of embankment from kilometer 11.53 to 11.75 kilometer.
- After erosion, river wave force directly hits Spar no 4 and government machinery started work at war level for saving spar no.4. If the Spar four, eroded situation will become more critical because after that fear of breach in the embankment will be definite.
- Hundred's of people and JCB's are regularly working and DM Barabanki and DM Gonda have been camping on the embankment site.
- If the embankment breached the some villages of district Barabanki and some villages of district Gonda are affected, because of river water moved directly Gonda side.
- If breach occurred approximately 1.5 to 2.5 lacks peoples will be affected.
- In the front of breached supposed villagers start evacuating. Mainly villagers of Raipur, Parsawal, Kamiyar.
- Last year same embankment faced breach at kilometer 15 in front of Parsawal village and due to breach approximately 150 villages and 2.5 lakhs people are affected in district Barabanki and Gonda.

Situation Report of Elgin Charsadi Embankment

Date: July 30, 2011

- Morning 4:30 the fourth Spar eroded by river Ghaghara
- Morning 6:00 am breached main embankment at kilometer 11.750.
- Water collecting in the area of ring embankment.
- Villagers are in fear and started evacuating.
- Water came from Nepal side show falling trend from all related bairaj between mornings 6 am to 9 am. Only from Sharada biraj trend are increasing.
