Keep drains clean. Don't change natural drainage



Don't place debris, waste material on a steep slope.



Don't construct



Tune to radio,



Subsidence of building,

near steep slopes & drainage path TV for updates & alerts cracks on rocks, muddy river water are warnings



Store emergency supplies of food and water, flashlights, batteries, and medicine ready Keep a disaster kit with essential identity documents ready



Ignore rumours. Stay calm. **Don't panic**

Stay together with your companions

Avoid staying in low-lying areas or valleys

Inform nearest Govt, **Disaster Management** Helpline.



Stay away from slide area **Don't drink unclean** There may be a danger water directly from of additional slides. river springs, wells





Check for injured or trapped persons



Don't move an injured person without rendering first aid unless he/she is in immediate danger

Don't touch/walk over loose material and electric wires or poles

Stay away from the location until experts confirm that it is safe
