Bus Accident in Madhya Pradesh

Background: A bus traveling to Indore in Madhya Pradesh fell off a bridge in Khargone's Dasanga Village on Tuesday around 9 am, killing at least 24 passengers on the spot. The bus was traveling to Indore when it skidded off the bridge and fell beneath.

SITUATION UPDATE AND RESPONSE

- At least **24 people, including 3 children and 6 women**, were killed and **25 others were injured**.
- More than **50 passengers** were traveling on the bus at the time of the accident.
- The injured passengers have been admitted to the district hospital Khargone.
- Emergency services with the help of local villagers are engaged in the rescue operation
- District Collector Mr. Sivraj Singh Verma, Superintendent of Police Mr. DS Yadav, and other officers have reached the spot to oversee the rescue work.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi's office announced that a compensation of Rs 2 lakh each will be given to the families of the deceased.
- Madhya Pradesh government has announced immediate financial assistance of Rs. 4 Lakh each to the families of the deceased, Rs. 50000 each to the seriously injured and Rs. 25000 each to those who received minor injuries.
